Nicho Hynes' boots were painted by 16 year old Kamilaroi male from Orana Juvenile Justice Centre Dubbo NSW.

The Orana boys used colours of the Storm or colours that contrasted well with the team colours. Whilst trying to add something of significance for them in the dot art patterns.

These boots were designed specifically with the player who will wear them in mind and the artwork intertwines elements of their story, with the young artist's own journey too.

Participating in 'Boots for Brighter Futures' provides young Indigenous peoples with an opportunity to connect with their culture and identity through art.

This process allows the artists to express themselves freely and most importantly, it empowers them to understand the value and importance of their own stories.
