Sam Verrills' boots were painted by a proud young Wiradjuri man at the Orana Youth Justice Centre at Dubbo.

These boots were designed specifically with the player who will wear them in mind and the artwork intertwines elements of their story, the Roosters colours, and with the young artist's own journey too.

Participating in 'Boots for Brighter Futures' provides young Indigenous peoples with an opportunity to connect with their sporting heroes through culture and art.

This process allows the artists to express themselves freely and most importantly, it empowers them to understand the value and importance of their own stories.

The boys love Rugby League and are extremely excited about the possibility of the players wearing their boots during the Indigenous Round of 2021.
